Realization of programmes in the course of training new quality specialists, scientists-researchers who will meet the requirements of labour market, European and Lithuania higher education politics. Quality management of study process in higher education institution and theoretical-empirical researches of lecturers' scientific, professional competences.

PROBLEM SPHERES OF THE CONFERENCE

- Interdisciplinarity of theoretical-empirical researches of education science.
- Evolution of education science in the processes of globalization and glocalization sciences: retrospections and perspectives.
- Evolution of education science in the contexts of changes of European and Lithuanian higher education and Education politics.
- Problems of modeling of education study programmes in higher education school in various study stages (I-II-III).
- Realization of programmes in the course of training new quality specialists, scientists-researchers.
- Quality management of study process in higher education institution.
- Theoretical-empirical researches of lecturers' scientific, educational competences.

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ARTICLES

Articles in native language as well as their translations into the English language are to be presented for printing (Times New Roman 12 font).

The following information about the author in native and English languages should be presented on a separate sheet of paper: name, surname, scientific degree and educational name, workplace, position, fields of scientific interests and contact information (address, telephone number, e-mail address).

At least one scientific review should be enclosed.

Article structure: *title* (14 pt, Bold). Institution represented is to be indicated below the name and surname of the author. If there is no an institution, the town and country of the author(s) are to be specified (12 pt, Italic). *Abstract* (the extent is 300-400 words) and 3-5 key words.

Research description and analysis: the problem of scientific research is to be formed together with the purpose, the degree of investigation of the problem under exploration is to be discussed, presented and motivated, the results of the research are to be illustrated with the tables and diagrams and brief as well as structured conclusions and discussions formulated.

Tables (10 pt, Normal) are to be numbered in Arabic numerals in the text. The number of the table and the word "Table" have to be written at the right margin of the text and the title of the table in bold in the centre of a new paragraph.

Pictures (10 pt, Normal) are to be numbered in Arabic numerals. The number of the picture in bold as well as the abbreviation for picture ("pict.") is to be written below the picture and the title of the picture afterwards.

The surname of the author **quoted** together with the first letter of his/her name and the date the work was issued are also to be specified within the text. When the exact quotation is presented in the text, the page number of quotation is also to be indicated after the year of the work issue.

Guide for the Reference Literature is to be presented below the articles in alphabetical order: first of all, the references according to the Roman alphabet are indicated and after that the references relating to other alphabets. The publications mentioned in the text are also to be specified indicating the surname, name initials, year (in brackets), title and reference (for example, periodical or edited book and its editors), town where the work was issued, publishing office and pages (if necessary).

Summary is to be presented in both versions of the articles referring to the language the article is written. The extent of the summary – not less than 4000 words.

CONFERENCE MATERIAL

The articles that meet the requirements for scientific works are foreseen to be printed in a separate set of scientific works "**Teacher Education**".
